Class Placement for Very Young Dancers

Our classes for Very Young Dancers are divided into two levels:

Ages 3-4 Creative Movement

Ages 5-6 Pre-Ballet/Tap

VYD classes present the building blocks of classical ballet and tap in an uplifting atmosphere full of fun and surprises. Children must be able to participate by themselves.

Class Placement for Fundamentals

Our fundamentals program begins at age seven and continues through adulthood with specialized classes in ballet, jazz, tap, hip hop, contemporary and musical theater. Classes are divided into progressive levels with placement by age and ability.

Closed Classes

Our classes do have an enrollment limit, however we do maintain waitlists. If you are interested in a closed class please let us know and we will keep you informed regarding availability.

Tuition and Fees

Tuition can be paid by semester or installments. Semester I tuition is due by October 1st, and Semester II tuition is due by March 1st. A finance charge of 5% will be assessed to any account paid past these dates.

There is a discount for electing to pay by semester and semesters run from September through January, and February through June.

Installment tuition is the undiscounted semester tuition divided into five equal payments over the course of a semester. Customers electing installment tuition must enroll in Auto-Pay. Your debit or credit card will be charged on the 2nd of each month of the enrolled semester.
